Such concerns should be brought to the attention of appropriate staff or to Board members by telephone, in writing, or by scheduling a personal meeting, as appropriate to the circumstances.

Visitors' comments will be limited to five (5) minutes for each agenda item upon which comment is made. Visitors are precluded from speaking on any agenda item more than once during each meeting.

**Policy and Procedure for Application to BOCES Long Island High School for the Arts
(Cultural Arts)**

Since Long Beach High School offers comprehensive programs in music, theatre arts and the visual arts, applications will not be accepted for consideration in these specific BOCES programs. Applications will only be considered for programs not available at Long Beach High School.

An eleventh or twelfth grade student wishing to participate in a BOCES Long Island High School for the Arts program must meet with his/her guidance counselor by February 1 of the preceding school year, to review his/her course history, success in course work, attendance and all other pertinent information. Course offerings in the specific cultural arts area of study will also be reviewed. The guidance counselor will notify the High School Principal, the Coordinator of Guidance, and the Director of Comprehensive Arts to set up an interview of the student candidate. The interview will include a review of the student's transcript, portfolio, record of participation in the area of interest outside the High School, discipline file, absences, discussion with the student, and any other pertinent information necessary. If the interview committee recommends the student for application to Long Island High School for the Arts, the information will be disseminated to the Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction. If the Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction decides to permit the student to apply, the student must then fill out an application to the BOCES Long Island High School for the Arts. The application must be submitted to the guidance counselor by March 1 of the preceding school year. The only exceptions will be students who enroll in the school district after March 1 of the prior year.

If approved by the Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction, students will be permitted to attend the Long Island High School for the Arts only if they are able to meet the requirements for a Regents Diploma. All are subject to acceptance by the BOCES Long Island High School for the Arts.
