Worksessions provide opportunities for the Board to deal with specific educational and other operational matters critical to the effective running of District, in order to provide the Board with the information they need to set school district policy. On occasion, the Board may include specific action items on the agenda prior to the start of the worksession or after the worksession business is concluded.

Visitors who wish to address the Board on matters other than those pertaining to the evening's worksession topic are asked to defer their comments until the next regular Board business meeting.
