FAIL TO FOLLOW NASSAU COUNTY TRAFFIC LAWS? YOUR E-BIKE OR SCOOTER IS NOW OURS

Any motorized scooter operated on the highway, parking lot, sidewalk, street or other public areas can be impounded.

Violations of Nassau County Miscellaneous Law, Title 61, are punishable by a fine **up to** \$700 for repeat offenders.

YOU MUST WEAR A HELMET

- **YOU CANNOT** be younger than 16 years old to drive an e-bike or scooter.
- YOU CANNOT drive on the sidewalk.
- YOU CANNOT drive over 20 mph.
