II.1 Superintendent Gallagher recommended the ACCEPTANCE OF VOTE FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT AND LIBRARY BOARD PROPOSITIONS, TRUSTEES AND BUDGET.

Acceptance of Vote for School/Library Propositions, Trustees and Budgets

Pursuant to Education Law, the District Clerk recommends that:

- a. The Board declares candidate Anne Conway having received the greatest number of votes for the one position of Trustee of the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of Long Beach, to be elected to the position of Trustee of the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of Long Beach for a term of three (3) years, beginning July 1, 2019.

- b. The Board accepts the vote on the proposed 2019-2020 school district budget for the City School District of the City of Long Beach as approved.
- c. The Board declares candidate MaryEllen Guarini having received the greatest number of votes to be elected to the position of Trustee of the Long Beach Public Library, for a term of five (5) years, beginning on July 1, 2019.
- d. The Board accepts the vote on the proposed 2019-2020 Library budget for the Long Beach Public Library as approval.

The Board of Education accepted the results without a vote.
Mr. Bodnar congratulated Mrs. Conway and wished her a happy birthday.
