President Posterli called the meeting to order at 5:35 PM and led the community in the Pledge of Allegiance. President Posterli stated that this would be our only in-person meeting until further notice to be in Covid compliance as we move into the reopening and thanked District staff and everyone who's been working so hard to get plans in place throughout the summer and into the fall to make our students as safe as possible.

### II. Audit Committee

Internal Audit Report and  
External Audit Report

1. Report by Shari Diamond, Internal Auditor of Cerini & Associates, LLP - Ms. Diamond explained the responsibility of the Internal Auditor is to assess the internal control system within the District, and to make recommendations to improve upon possible control weaknesses or deficiencies in order to provide assurance to the District's Board, management, and residents, that the fiscal operations of the District are being handled appropriately and effectively. Ms. Diamond presented a Risk Assessment Report, a Review of Information Technology Environment, as well as the Annual Monitoring Report for the District for 2018-19. With regard to IT, Mr. Pinto asked how we would teach our younger students about cyber security. Dr. Romanelli stated that Digital Citizenship Best Practices would be part of the curriculum and be built into virtual instruction.

2. Report by External Auditor, Jill Sanders, of Cullen & Danowski LLP- Ms. Sanders explained the purpose of the Audit is to express an opinion about whether the district's financial statements are free from misstatement and fairly presented, to report on control over financial reporting and compliance with laws, and to present an opinion on extra classroom activity funds. Ms. Sander's presentation is posted on the District website.

### III. Superintendent's Report – Dr. Gallagher

The Superintendent introduced Dr. Paul Romanelli, who presented a Summary of Committees Work. Dr. Romanelli presented a report on Committee Summaries on Curriculum, Social and Emotional Learning and Equity. This presentation is posted on the District website.

### IV. President Posterli called for Board of Education Comments

BOE Comments

- Anne Conway commended the committees, noted the students on the committees, and asked how the Covid restrictions would affect play breaks. Dr. Romanelli replied that they would definitely be looking at ways to utilize both indoor and outdoor space as much as possible for opportunities for play.
- With respect to block scheduling at the HS, did the committee make any recommendations on that?
- Ms. Conway asked about diverse hiring practices, are we using OLAS? Dr. Romanelli replied the District is not using OLAS but has been involved in Diverse Hiring Fairs and utilizes much of the same practices.
- Ms. Conway discussed moving away from textbooks, which are outdated and moving toward diverse literature.
- Dr. Ryan thanked the Auditors for their presentations and Dr. Kiley-Rendon for productive Technology meetings. Dr. Ryan also expressed concern for diversity with regard to athletic programs, as well as theatre arts and music.
- President Posterli asked about the mental health aspect, for mental health screening, is South Oaks going to be involved in the screening process? Dr. Romanelli said that PPS is still working on the form that will be going out to students. Dr. Gallagher replied that would be for a higher level of need, but that they have been great in advising the District.
- President Posterli asked how the effectiveness of the Choose Love and Mental Health programming would be measured. Dr. Romanelli replied benchmarks will be developed to measure all 4 aspects.
- President Posterli praised the Equity Committee and asked about equity in access to technology and chromebooks and Dr. Romanelli replied every student will have access to chromebooks and internet access.

- Dr. Ryan asked about Pre-K registration and Dr. Gallagher replied that we are down 40 from last year.
- Dr. Ryan asked about the Columbia Literacy Program in terms of Covid – Dr. Gallagher replied their model is for them to send a staff developer to the District. Much of their Professional Development will also be virtual.
- Dr. Ryan asked if we would be posting information on the reopening of schools, and Dr. Gallagher replied the Reopening Plan will be posted on the District website, will email parents and post information on Facebook, and will provide weekly updates as well.
- Ms. Conway spoke about how important it is to complete the census, which determines funding for our schools. Dr. Gallagher stated that she had done one email blast regarding the census and will be doing another. Ms. Conway asked about safety guidelines and training the coaches receive. Mr. Epstein replied that coaches are required by NYS to have certain credentials and that they also undergo training on how to respond to various situations, decision-making processes, reporting issues of concern, etc. He stressed that all coaches should treat students with dignity and respect. Dr. Natali also stated that Athletics is an extension of the school day, and therefore the Code of Conduct spells out expectations regarding Essential Partners – all teachers, staff and coaches are essential partners.
- President Posterli asked if any Board members would be permitted to walk around and view the ESY program this summer and Dr. Gallagher replied no, due to confidentiality and that the program is going very well. Also, with regard to virtual summer school, Dr. Romanelli said that the synchronis (live direct instruction) and asynchornis (teacher gives and assignment – virtual work) models are going very well. Mrs. Vrona asked is the Board would be doing an inspection of buildings and Dr. Gallagher replied she wasn't sure, perhaps one representative of the Board

could tour the buildings, as they are trying to limit outside persons entering the buildings. Mrs. Vrona also asked the attorney about whether or not a Board member could virtually attend and vote at a Board meeting while "quarantining". The Open Meetings Law would still be in place as long as the Governor still has the Emergency Powers (Act).
