## I. Pledge of Allegiance/Superintendent's Opening Remarks/Call to Order

Board Member Dr. Ryan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led everyone in the pledge of allegiance. Dr. Ryan congratulated East school students who assumed the running for a \$100,000 prize and mentioned the sports awards. He extended Mr. Pinto and Mrs. Pace's regrets for not being able to obtain the meeting.

### II. Superintendent's Report - Dr. Gallagher

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Gallagher announced that two tenth grade students are moving to round two of the Long Island Science and Engineering fair. Dr. Gallagher introduced High School Staff and Students to present the AVID program.

Student Showcase: AVID

Mrs. Walsh Burger thanked everyone for their time. She spoke about AVID 101 and explained the AVID program. She introduced the teachers and Guidance Counselor who comprise the site team. Mrs. Walsh Bulger discussed what College and Career readiness looks like. Students in the program spoke about how AVID has helped them with Focus notes, helped build friendships, reading and writing skills, skills to help improve

learning. Avid has also helped students explore their future college plans, be organized, advocate for yourself, prepare for college application process, Board Member stated the Board may have a few questions.

- Ms. Bellsey stated she was impressed with the journal / learning log. She asked what kind of community service projects they have been working on. Students replied that they participated in Soles for Souls, Sold waffles as a fundraiser.
- Ms. Conway thanked everyone for the presentation and is happy to hear that the students are all looking forward to their future plans.
- Dr. Ryan thanked the presenters for coming out. He asked students what would your high school experience have been without AVID? Student answered that it helped her be more organized. How big is the AVID class? Ms. Walsh Bulger replied that they currently have 29 applications. Dr. Ryan asked what Staff Development looks like for AVID? Ms. Walsh Burger replied staff has been AVID trained to provide professional development, Monday Committee meetings, training with Regional representative. Dr. Ryan stated that it sounds like the program is based on solid educational instruction.

## Presentation: Transportation Budget

Dr. Gallagher introduced Mr. DeVito. Mr. DeVito introduced the new Director of Transportation, Mr. Paul Weydig. Mr. DeVito explained the transportation service provided is four separate functions: District Transportation, Transportation Garage. Contract Transportation and BOCES Transportation and the cost drivers for the budget. Mr. DeVito then gave upcoming dates for other budgets.

- Dr. Ryan asked what the general state of the fleet is. Mr. DeVito replied the buses are in good condition. Dr. Ryan also asked the about the state of the Depot. Mr. DeVito replied that a wall was replaced and painted, installed a new sewer line. Mr. Grillo has not indicated anything that needs immediate attention. Dr. Ryan asked about the shortage of drivers. Mr. DeVito replied they are not comfortable with the amount of drivers. Dr. Ryan thanked Mr. Weydig for the transition that he made.
- Dr. Ryan commented on the first day of school being the most stressful for Transportation. He stated that district is having fewer emergencies.
- Ms. Bellsey asked if the training program for drivers is universal across Long Island. Mr. DeVito stated it's a national problem.
- Mrs. Conway asked how students the district busses? Mr. DeVito replied that its
  about 2,000 students actually ride, 700 students taken to private school. Ms.
  Conway asked if the 3 bus driver vacancies are filled, will district be able to reduce
  the dependency on BOCES? Mr. DeVito replied that he does not think so. Mrs.
  Conway asked the price of buses purchased this year. Mr/ DeVito replied large
  buses are about \$200,000.
